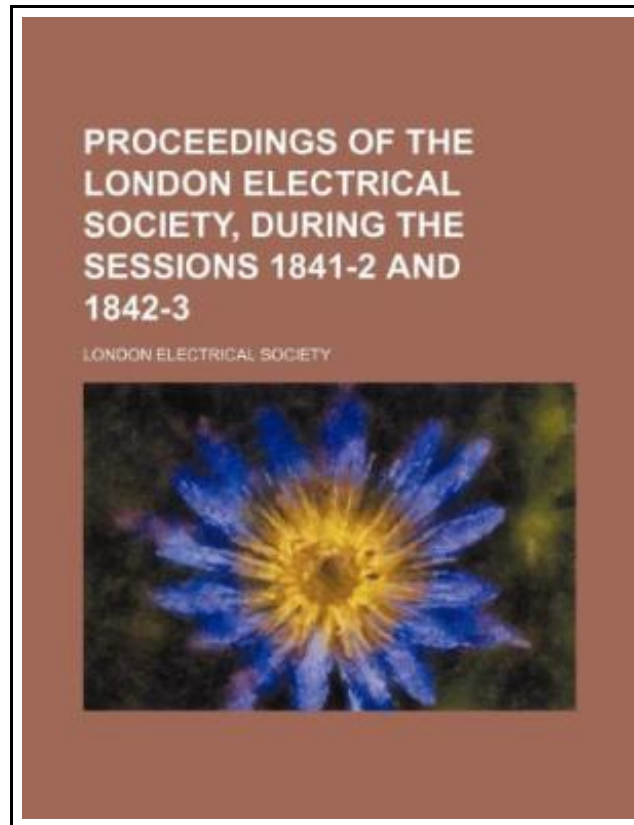

Now, this influence of heat can scarcely be explained by the chemical theory; for, as Mr. Faraday himself very justly observes, it does not depend on chemical action, seeing that it is manifested by heating the electrode which does not act chemically upon the conducting liquid; neither is it a thermo-electric phenomenon, since the heat increases the force of the current only when it is applied to the electro-negative metal of the pair. From this, Mr. Faraday, who does not admit the contact theory, conceives that this influence of heat is due to its facilitating the passage of the current, or to its increasing the conductivity of the system; but this explanation is not based on any positive fact, whilst the thing is easily explained by the contact theory, admitting that heat modifies the electrical condition of metals in the manner I have pointed out; which is, besides, confirmed by the passivity and peculiar electro-chemical properties presented by iron after it has been heated. Now, among these phenomena, there are in fact, it is not possible to advance any chemical reason why the iron should be more attackable in nitric acid, with two or three atoms of water, than in nitric acid with one atom of water, since, in both cases, it is oxidized at the expense of the acid only, and not of the water added. t Annalen eon...
